An interactive installation at the Great North Museum exhibit of the Lindow Man. This exhibit consisted of two 1.5m diameter circular multi-touch surfaces running a WPF powered application that allowed visitors of the museum to find out more about the Lindow Man through by performing a CSI style 'autopsy' on the digital body.
